Boarding at ClubK-9, Inc. is a unique experience designed to relieve the stress, which normally accompanies the separation of furry family members from their non-furry counterparts. We are a Doggy Hotel and in no way are designed to be a kennel. After breakfast each morning guests join their friends and our staff for a day of fun and frolic in our spacious indoor play areas. Our fabulous staff provides activity and attention to meet the demands of each individual guest. Some of our guests enjoy playing ball all-day or splashing in our wading pool, while others would prefer to be carried or cuddled. We gladly accommodate all of our guests' special needs. Our goal is for the activity of the day to lead to a relaxed sleepy guest at night. Our guests enjoy dinner at approximately 4:00pm and then have several more hours to socialize and get ready for a good nights sleep. We have created a sleeping environment that has all of the comforts of home. Each guest has a perfectly pup-sized private bedroom with a nice cozy raised bed & rug.

Not everyone can be a Club K-9 member. This is a place for dogs that enjoy socializing with new dogs and our staff and after a long day of play rest peacefully. This is not the place for overly shy, fearful, ill-mannered, or aggressive dogs. If your dog does not enjoy this experience and/or makes the experience un-safe or unpleasant for himself/herself, other guests, or our staff Club K-9 will revoke his/her membership. Please, see Daycare/Boarding Agreement & Release, especially sections 3,5 & 6.

All of our suites are furnished with rugs to relax on and raised beds for a rejuvenating night's sleep. Please, tell us if you would like us to remove any furnishings from your dog's room. Dogs are not separated by chain link but instead by wooden doors and beautifully painted walls. This is not the place for a destructive dog. We recommend that if your dog has not been left for the night in a confined space such as your bathroom or utility room, or if he/she has never been boarded before that you experiment a little before his/her first experience with us. If he/she is crate trained we urge you to bring his/her crate. You are also welcome to bring bedding, however, if it is soiled and/or destroyed by your dog it will be bagged and returned to you in that condition. Our laundry service will only launder our beds and towels. Please, see Daycare/Boarding Agreement & Release, especially sections 2,3, & 6.

We require that all guests come with enough food for their entire stay, so that we can keep them on the diet which they are accustomed to and avoid any intestinal upset. We recommend that you bring special treats, chewies, toys, and anything else that you would like in their room to make their stay more enjoyable. Please, make sure these are all items that you feel comfortable with your furry family member having when left unsupervised in his/her room. Please, see Daycare/Boarding Agreement & Release, especially sections 1& 6.

Missed Meal Information:

If your dog refuses to eat more than 2 consecutive meals Club K-9, Inc. may begin to add chicken broth, cottage cheese, canned food and other food items to entice him/her. Please, note if there are any foods your dog may not eat.

Stomach Upset:

If your dog vomits several times and/or begins to have chronic diarrhea Club K-9, Inc. will take him/her off of his/her regular diet and feed rice and cottage until the upset ceases. Please, note if there is any reason we should not do this.

Illness:

If your dog becomes ill during his/her stay at Club K-9, Inc., we will make every attempt to reach you. However, this may not be possible. If Club K-9 takes your dog to the veterinarian there will be a \$25.00 trip charge and a charge of \$5.00 per hour in addition to all veterinary fees. Club K-9 will take your dog to the veterinarian of our choice.

Unusual Situations:

Please, make sure that Club K-9, Inc. can reach you while you are away and that we have current emergency contact information. If for the safety of your dog or those around him/her we must remove your dog from the premises it is always best if you have someone that can pick your dog up. If a Club K-9 employee has to bring your dog anywhere there will be a \$5.00 trip charge. If a Club K-9 employee has to have your dog spend the night in our home we will charge an additional \$10.00 per night.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up:

All dogs must be dropped-off between 7:00 and 10:00a.m.on Mon.-Fri., and between 10:00 and 11a.m. on Sat. & Sun. Check-out for boarding is by 1:00pm. Dogs are welcome to stay for daycare on the day of pick-up and there is an additional \$16.00 charge for that service. Any dog that is not picked up by 6:00pm on Mon.-Fri. and 4:00pm on Sat. & Sun will be boarded at the rate of whatever room is available. If there is no space available owners will be responsible for any and all fees that apply. Please, note we are closed for naps from 1:00 to 3:00 Mon.-Fri.
